

Fire Safety Checklist

Ensures fire safety procedures are in place, including fire extinguishers, exits, and emergency response plans.

- Are fire extinguishers accessible and functional?
- Are fire exits clearly marked and unobstructed?
- Are flammable materials stored properly?
- Are emergency procedures displayed on-site?
- Is fire-fighting equipment inspected regularly?
- Are workers trained in fire response procedures?
- Are fire-resistant materials used where needed?
- Are no-smoking policies enforced?
- Are electrical hazards identified for fire risks?
- Are hot work permits required for welding or grinding?
- Are sprinkler systems functional where applicable?
- Is an emergency assembly point designated?
- Are gas leaks checked regularly?
- Are fire blankets available in key areas?
- Are waste disposal areas clear of flammable debris?
